GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

BICENTENARY OF THE GIBRALTAR CHRONICLE £5 COIN NOTICE 2001

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Bicentenary of the Gibraltar Chronicle £5 Coin Notice 2001.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and mixed metal in the denomination of £5 shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part I of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (this is, a variation of the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the right and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” to the left and the date of the year below;

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the insignia of the Castle and Keys together with the design of the front page of the Gibraltar Chronicle breaking the news of Nelson's victory off Cape Trafalgar, overlaid with a scene from the Sea Battle of Trafalgar, with the "Victory" centre and the inscriptions "TRAFALGAR 1805" AND "BICENTENARY OF THE CHRONICLE" and the value of the coin.

Legal tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
