LEGAL NOTICE NO. 10 OF 2002

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

**GOLDEN JUBILEE OF HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II
COIN NOTICE 2002**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Golden Jubilee of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II Coin 2002.

Issue of new coins.

2. (1) New coins of platinum, gold and silver in the denomination of a Crown and a Sovereign and denominations thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (this is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

(a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the right and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” to the left and the date of the year below;

(b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of—

(i) of a portrait after a photograph of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, at the Trooping of the Colour in 1964, cradling in her arms the infant Prince Edward and watched over by His Royal Highness Prince Philip,

Duke of Edinburgh, with a depiction of decorative wood sorrel, together with the inscriptions of the official insignia of The Queen's Golden Jubilee 2002, and "GOLDEN JUBILEE OF QUEEN ELIZABETH 1952-2002" and the value of the coin;

- (ii) of a portrait in profile of Their Royal Highnesses Princess Elizabeth and Prince Philip on their Honeymoon in 1952 against the background of "Treetops", the location in Kenya at which Her Majesty learned of the death of her Father and of her Accession to the Throne, together with the inscriptions of the official insignia of The Queen's Golden Jubilee 2002, and "GOLDEN JUBILEE OF QUEEN ELIZABETH 1952 - 2002" and the value of the coin;
- (iii) depicting the Royal Yacht "Britannia sailing under Tower Bridge in 1954 bringing Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II home from an overseas tour which included a visit to Gibraltar, together with the inscriptions of the official insignia of The Queen's Golden Jubilee 2002, and "GOLDEN JUBILEE OF QUEEN ELIZABETH 1952 - 2002" and the value of the coin;
- (iv) depicting the Coronation Coach with, inset, a cameo portrait of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II of Her Coronation Day together with the inscriptions of the official insignia of The Queen's Golden Jubilee 2002, and "GOLDEN JUBILEE OF QUEEN ELIZABETH 1952 - 2002" and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
