## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990 GOLDEN JUBILEE OF HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH II £5 COIN NOTICE 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

### 1. Title.

This notice may be cited as Golden Jubilee of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II £5 Coin Notice 2002.

### 2. Issue of new coins.

(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and mixed metal in the denomination of £5 shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metal, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part I of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation of the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said part of the Schedule.

### 3. Design of the coins.

The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the right and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” to the left and the date of the year below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting the coronation of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II by the

Archbishop of Canterbury together with the inscriptions of the official insignia of The Queen's Golden Jubilee 2002, and "GOLDEN JUBILEE OF QUEEN ELIZABETH 1952–2002" and the value of the coin.

**4. Legal Tender.**

The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
