LEGAL NOTICE NO. 13 OF 2003

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

OLYMPIC GAMES 2004 CROWN COIN NOTICE 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as Olympic Games 2004 Crown Coin Notice 2003.

Issue of New Coins.

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness, or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the Coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear—

- (i) a design of two hockey players, from the base of a marble statue, in the Greek National Museum, Athens, from c.510 BC, surrounded by a wreath of olive leaves together with the inscriptions “XXVII OLYMPIC GAMES” and “ATHENS 2004” and the value of the coin; or
- (ii) a design of jumping horse and rider, from a bronze statue in the Greek National Museum, Athens of horse and jockey from the Hellenistic period, 336 BC, surrounded by a wreath of olive leaves together with the inscriptions “XXVII OLYMPIC GAMES” and “ATHENS 2004” and the value of the coin; or
- (iii) a design of two wrestlers from a Greek drinking cup in the British Museum, London called “The Heave” from c.475–450 BC, surrounded by a wreath of olive leaves together with the inscriptions “XXVII OLYMPIC GAMES” and “ATHENS 2004” and the value of the coin; or
- (iv) a design of a javelin thrower from the Red Figure Cup, in the State Museum, Berlin, Germany, from the late 5th Century BC, surrounded by a wreath of olive leaves together with the inscriptions “XXVII OLYMPIC GAMES” and “ATHENS 2004” and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
