LEGAL NOTICE NO. 2 OF 2005

## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

### ISSUE OF THE 200<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE BATTLE OF TRAFALGAR COIN NOTICE 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

#### **Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of The 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Battle of Trafalgar Coin Notice, 2005.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of £5, £1 and crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

(a) each coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the year 2005 to the right;

(b) the reverse impression shall bear—

(i) a design that features the first shots being fired by Admiral Collingwood's flagship HMS Royal Sovereign against the Spanish flagship Santa Anna. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;

(ii) a design that features HMS Victory 'breaking the line' astern of the French ship the Bucentaure with the other French ship the Redoutable also near. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;

(iii) a design that features the portrait of Admiral Lord Cuthbert Collingwood. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;

(iv) a design that features the death of Admiral Lord Nelson. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;

(v) a design that features Admiral Nelson briefing his officers. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;

(vi) a design that features an overview plan of the 'Nelson Touch'. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
