GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

ISSUE OF GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY COIN NOTICE 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Great Battles in History Coin Notice 2005.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of £5 and crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Parts of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) each coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear—

- (i) a design featuring the Battle of Hastings. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF HASTINGS 1066” and the value of the coin;
- (ii) a design featuring the Battle of Agincourt. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF AGINCOURT 1415” and the value of the coin;
- (iii) a design featuring the Battle of Waterloo. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF WATERLOO 1815” and the value of the coin;
- (iv) a design featuring the Battle of Leipzig. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF LEIPZIG 1813” and the value of the coin;
- (v) a design featuring the Battle of Yorktown. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF YORKTOWN 1781” and the value of the coin;
- (vi) a design featuring the Battle of the Somme. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF THE SOMME 1916” and the value of the coin;
- (vii) a design featuring the Battle of Gettysburg. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF GETTYSBURG 1863” and the value of the coin;
- (viii) a design featuring the Battle of Gallipoli. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF GALLIPOLI 1915” and the value of the coin;
- (ix) a design featuring the Battle of Little Big Horn. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT

BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “LITTLE BIG HORN 1876” and the value of the coin;

- (x) a design featuring the Battle of Rorke’s Drift. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “RORKE’S DRIFT 1879” and the value of the coin;
- (xi) a design featuring the Battle of Arbela-Guagamala. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF ARBELA-GUAGAMALA 331 BC” and the value of the coin;
- (xii) a design featuring the Battle of Zama. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “GREAT BATTLES IN HISTORY”, “BATTLE OF ZAMA 202 BC” and the value of the coin;

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
