GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE 200th ANNIVERSARY OF THE BATTLE OF TRAFALGAR COIN (No. 2) NOTICE 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of The 200th Anniversary of the Battle of Trafalgar Coin (No. 2) Notice 2005.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of £5, £1 and crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Parts of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) each coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the year 2005 to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear—

- (i) a design that features two sailors from HMS Victory giving effect to Admiral Nelson's message to the rest of the fleet. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005", "ENGLAND EXPECTS EVERY MAN WILL DO HIS DUTY" and the value of the coin;
- (ii) a design that features HMS Neptune towing HMS Victory to Gibraltar. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (iii) a design that features Nelson's Column in Trafalgar Square, London. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (iv) a design that features young Nelson. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (v) a design that features Admiral Nelson's funeral procession on the River Thames. The writing in the background is from a reading at Nelson's funeral. HMS Victory is also depicted in the background. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (vi) a design that features Admiral Nelson at his desk. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
