GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE CONCORDE MILESTONES COIN NOTICE 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of The Concorde Milestones Coin Notice 2006.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of £10, £5 and £1 shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear—

- (i) a design featuring the Launch of the first Concorde Prototype. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ROLL OUT OF THE CONCORDE PROTOTYPE” and the value of the coin;
- (ii) a design featuring the maiden test flight of Concorde. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “MAIDEN TEST FLIGHT OF CONCORDE” and the value of the coin;
- (iii) a design featuring the first supersonic flight. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “FIRST SUPERSONIC FLIGHT OF CONCORDE” and the value of the coin;
- (iv) a design featuring Concorde taking the speed record. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “CONCORDE TAKES THE SPEED RECORD” and the value of the coin;
- (v) a design featuring the first commercial flight of Concorde. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “FIRST COMMERCIAL FLIGHT OF CONCORDE” and the value of the coin;
- (vi) a design featuring the Queen's first flight on Concorde. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “QUEEN ELIZABETH II FIRST FLIGHT ON CONCORDE” and the value of the coin;
- (vii) a design featuring the London to Sydney record being set. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “CONCORDE'S LONDON TO SYDNEY RECORD” and the value of the coin;
- (viii) a design featuring the first around the world flight. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “CONCORDE'S FIRST AROUND THE WORLD FLIGHT” and the value of the coin;
- (ix) a design featuring the New York to London record being set. Included on the coin are the inscriptions

“CONCORDE'S NEW YORK TO LONDON RECORD” and the value of the coin;

- (x) a design featuring the Queen's Golden Jubilee Flypast. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “CONCORDE'S GOLDEN JUBILEE FLYPAST” and the value of the coin;
- (xi) a design featuring the last ever commercial flight. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “LAST COMMERCIAL FLIGHT OF CONCORDE” and the value of the coin;
- (xii) a design featuring the final flight of Concorde. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “FINAL FLIGHT OF CONCORDE” and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
