GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

**ISSUE OF THE DIAMOND WEDDING COLLECTION
NOTICE 2007**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Diamond Wedding Collection Notice 2007.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of £10, £5, £1 and crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear–
- (i) a design featuring a three-quarter length portrait of the newly married Princess Elizabeth and Philip, Duke of Edinburgh on their wedding day. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “DIAMOND WEDDING”, wedding bells and the value of the coin.
 - (ii) a design featuring a recent portrait of Queen Elizabeth II and the Duke of Edinburgh, in profile. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “DIAMOND WEDDING”, wedding bells and the value of the coin.
 - (iii) a design featuring the newly married Princess Elizabeth and Philip, Duke of Edinburgh in the Glass Coach en route to Buckingham Palace, on their wedding day. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “DIAMOND WEDDING”, wedding bells and the value of the coin.
 - (iv) a design featuring Westminster Abbey – the venue of the wedding ceremony of Princess Elizabeth and Philip, Duke of Edinburgh. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “DIAMOND WEDDING”, wedding bells and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
