**ISSUE OF THE QUEEN ELIZABETH II DIAMOND JUBILEE COIN
(NO. 2) NOTICE 2011**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Coin (No. 2) Notice 2011.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold and silver plated cupro-nickel in the denomination of £5, £2, £0.50 and One Crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring a double portrait of the newly crowned young Queen together with the present image of Her Majesty. The inscription includes “HM QUEEN ELIZABETH II DIAMOND JUBILEE 1952-2012”, and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
