GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

**ISSUE OF THE BIRTHDAY COMMEMORTIVE COIN NOTICE
2012**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for Finance has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the Birthday Commemorative Coin Notice, 2012.

Issue of new coin.

2.(1) New coins of gold and silver in the denomination of £100 and £5 shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coin, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left, the inscription “QUEEN OF GIBRALTAR” to the right and the date of the year below;
- (b) the reverse design bears the music to commemorate the 100th Anniversary of the first appearance of the combination of melody and lyrics in “Happy Birthday to You” in print in

1912. The inscription includes “HAPPY BIRTHDAY” in five different languages that reflect the unique diversity of Gibraltar, namely English, Spanish, Arabic, Hebrew and Hindi, and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
