## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

### ISSUE OF THE BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC COIN – PART 2, NOTICE 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

#### **Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as issue of the coin to commemorate The Battle of the Atlantic – Part 2, notice 2016.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of silver in the denomination of Half Crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The designs of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows–

- (a) the coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II DEI GRA REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, and the value and the date of the year below. A privy mark depicting an anchor will be shown to the lower left of the effigy.
- (b) The reverse impressions shall bear–

- (i) a design depicting a merchant ship in the background, a German heavy cruiser in the foreground and German Luftwaffe planes at the top. An inscription with the words “UNRECOGNIZED, YOU PUT US IN YOUR DEBT” will be shown bordering the top edge.
- (ii) a design depicting a merchant ship in the background and a German U-boat in the foreground. An inscription with the words “UNTHANKED, YOU ENTER, OR ESCAPE, THE GRAVE” will be shown bordering the bottom edge.
- (iii) a design depicting the SS Gairsoppa in the foreground and a map of the world with the Gairsoppa’s last voyage represented as a dotted line in the background. An inscription with the words “WHETHER YOUR LAND REMEMBER OR FORGET” will be shown bordering the top edge.
- (iv) a design depicting a sailor at the helm of a merchant ship. An inscription with the words “YOU SAVED THE LAND, OR DIED TO TRY TO SAVE” will be shown bordering the top edge.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
