GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

**ISSUE OF THE 80th ANNIVERSARY OF THE YEAR OF THE
THREE KINGS SOVEREIGN COLLECTION, NOTICE 2016**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice –

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as Issue of the Coins to Commemorate the 80th Anniversary of the Year of the Three Kings, Notice 2016.

Issue of new coins.

2. (1) New coins of gold in the denominations of Quarter Sovereign, Half Sovereign, One Sovereign, Two Sovereigns and Five Sovereigns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Parts of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The designs of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II DEI GRA REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, and the year of the coin below.

- (b) The reverse impression shall bear;
- i. a design depicting a portrait of George V in the background with the words “George V” and the dates “1910 – 1936” in the foreground. A privy mark consisting of the number 3 in Roman numerals and a crown above it will be shown on the right.
 - ii. a design depicting a portrait of George VI in the background with the words “George VI” and the dates “1936 – 1952” in the foreground. A privy mark consisting of the number 3 in Roman numerals and a crown above it will be shown on the right.
 - iii. a design depicting a portrait of Edward VIII in the background with the words “Edward VIII” and the date “1936” in the foreground. A privy mark consisting of the number 3 in Roman numerals and a crown above it will be shown on the right.
4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
