GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

**ISSUE OF THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF WORLD WAR ONE
PART ONE COIN NOTICE 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the 100th Anniversary of World War One Part One Coin Notice 2018 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver, cupro nickel and tombac in the denomination of One Crown, 1/10 Crown, ¼ Crown, ½ Crown, Double Crown, Quarter Sovereign, Half Sovereign, One Sovereign, Two Sovereigns and Five Sovereigns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Parts II and VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II D G REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge and the value and date of the year below;

- (b) the reverse impression depicts a silhouette of the Lone Soldier stood with rifle pointing down to signify the end of the fighting. The dates 1914 and 1918 sit at the 9 o'clock and 3 o'clock positions respectively. The encircling inscription reads 'WE ARE THE DEAD SHORT DAYS AGO WE LIVED FELT DAWN SAW SUNSET GLOW LIVED AND WERE LOVED AND NOW WE LIE IN FLANDERS FIELDS.'

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
