GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE 100th YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF ARMISTICE & REMEMBRANCE DAY SOVEREIGN COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of 100th Year Anniversary of Armistice & Remembrance Day Sovereign Collection Coins Notice 2019 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold in the denomination of a Quarter, Half, One, Two and Five Sovereigns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II DEI GRA REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, date of the year below
- (b) the reverse impression of the Quarter Sovereign shall bear a design depicting The Battle of Mons, the first major battle of the Great War. The inscription bordering the bottom reads ‘MONS 1914 – 1918’.
- (c) the reverse impression of the Half Sovereign shall bear a design depicting The Battle of Loos, remembered as the biggest attack of 1915. The inscription bordering the right side of the coin reads ‘LOOS 1914-1918’.

- (d) the reverse impression of the Sovereign shall bear a design depicting The Battle of Somme, seen as the bloodiest battle of WWI. The inscription bordering the bottom reads 'SOMME 1914-1918'.
- (e) the reverse impression of the Double Sovereign shall bear a design depicting The Battle of Dover Straits, where the outnumbered British prevented a German invasion. The inscription reads 'DOVER STRAITS' bordering the bottom and the years '1914 -1918' bordering the top .
- (f) the reverse impression of the Quintuple Sovereign shall bear a design depicting The Battle of Amiens, the 100 day offensive and essentially the road to victory. The inscription reads 'AMIENS' bordering the top and the years '1914 -1918' bordering the bottom

Legal Tender.

- 4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
