## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

### ISSUE OF THE WORLD WAR II OUTBREAK – 80<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY COLLECTION – THE ROAD TO VICTORY PART ONE, COIN NOTICE 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the World War II Outbreak – 80th Anniversary Collection – The Road to Victory Part One, Coin Notice 2019 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of cupro nickel, silver and gold in the denominations of 1/2 Crown, Crown, Double Crown and Five Pounds shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Parts I, II and IX of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II.D.G.REGINA.GIBRALTAR” bordering the edge, date of the year and value below;
- (b) the reverse impression of the D-Day 75th Anniversary coin shall bear a printed photograph showing a wave of soldiers just about to storm the beaches. The image is printed upon stacked letters and postcards with the inscription “1939” at the top and “1945” at the bottom;

- (c) the reverse impression of the Battle of Britain coin shall bear a printed photograph showing the Allied Forces in formation in the skies. The image is printed upon stacked letters and postcards with the inscription “1939” at the top and “1945” at the bottom;
- (d) the reverse impression of the Pearl Harbour coin shall bear a printed photograph showing the destruction caused by the Japanese aircrafts at the Hawaiian naval base. The image is printed upon stacked letters and postcards with the inscription “1939” at the top and “1945” at the bottom;
- (e) the reverse impression of the Operation Torch coin shall bear a printed photograph showing young soldiers heading directly into battle. The image is printed upon stacked letters and postcards with the inscription “1939” at the top and “1945” at the bottom;
- (f) the reverse impression of the Battle of Stalingrad coin shall bear a printed photograph showing soldiers mid-battle with their surroundings totally destroyed from warfare. The image is printed upon stacked letters and postcards with the inscription “1939” at the top and “1945” at the bottom;
- (g) the reverse impression of the Battle of Atlantic coin shall bear a printed photograph showing the war at sea as the ocean erupts in front of the war ship. The image is printed upon stacked letters and postcards with the inscription “1939” at the top and “1945” at the bottom;
- (h) the reverse impression of the Operation Gunnerside coin shall bear a printed photograph showing the Norwegian Squadron who were involved in the operation. The image is printed upon stacked letters and postcards with the inscription “1939” at the top and “1945” at the bottom; and
- (i) the reverse impression of the Peace 1945 coin shall bear a design depicting a dove with an olive branch in its beak and a “V” for victory sign in the background. A laurel wreath frames the design and the inscription at the bottom reads “1939-1945”.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
