GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE TWELVE LABOURS OF HERCULES £2 COINS NOTICE 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice–

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Twelve Labours of Hercules £2 Coins Notice 2019.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

3.(1) New coins of bi-metal nickel brass – cupro nickel in the denomination of two pounds shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part I of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows–

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II. D. G. REGINA . GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, date of the year below; and

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hercules wrestling with the Nemean Lion together with the inscription “THE NEMEAN LION”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hercules killing a nine-headed snake together with the inscription “THE LERNEAN HYDRA”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of the capture of a stag together with the inscription “THE CERYNEIAN HIND”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of the capture of the Erymanthian Boar together with the inscription “THE ERYMANTHIAN BOAR”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (f) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hercules cleaning stables together with the inscription “THE AUGEIAS’ STABLES”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (g) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hercules shooting at birds with a bow and arrow, together with the inscription “THE STYMPHALION BIRDS”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (h) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hercules fighting with the Cretan Bull, together with the inscription “THE CRETAN BULL”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (i) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Diomedes being fed to mares, held by Hercules, together with the inscription “THE MARES OF DIOMEDES”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (j) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hercules retrieving the girdle of Hippolyte, together with the inscription “THE GIRDLE OF HIPPOLYTE”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;
- (k) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hercules obtaining the cattle of Geryon, together with the inscription “THE CATTLE OF GERYON”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below;

- (l) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hercules in the garden of Hesperides, together with the inscription “THE APPLES OF HESPERIDES”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below; and
- (m) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of the capture of a multi-headed hound, together with the inscription “CERBERUS”. The inscription bordering the coin reads “THE LABOURS OF HERCULES” and the value shown below.

Legal Tender.

- 5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
