GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF CIRCULATING COINS – ISLAND GAMES NOTICE 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice–

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of Circulating Coins – Island Games Notice 2019.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

3.(1) New coins of copper plated steel, nickel plated steel, cupro nickel, nickel brass and mixed metal in the denominations of one pence, two pence, five pence, ten pence, twenty pence, fifty pence, one pound and two pounds shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part I of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows–

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II. D. G. REGINA. GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, date of the year below;
- (b) the one pence coin shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Swimming logo of the Island Games. The inscription reads “1” on the top right side of the coin;

- (c) the two pence coin shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Beach Volleyball logo of the Island Games. The inscription reads “2” on the bottom right side of the coin;
- (d) the five pence coin shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Athletics logo of the Island Games. The inscription reads “5” on the right side of the coin;
- (e) the ten pence coin shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Table Tennis logo of the Island Games. The inscription reads “10” on the top left side of the coin;
- (f) the twenty pence coin shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Triathlon logo of the Island Games. The inscription bordering the edge of the coin reads “ISLAND GAMES” together with the value of the coin;
- (g) the fifty pence coin shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Sailing logo of the Island Games. The inscription reads “50” on the top right side of the coin;
- (h) the one pound coin shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Tennis logo of the Island Games. The inscription reads “£1” on the right side of the coin; and
- (i) the two pound coin shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Cycling logo of the Island Games. The inscription bordering the edge of the coin reads “ISLAND GAMES” together with the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
