LEGAL NOTICE NO. 105 OF 2020

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE UEFA EURO 2020 – ONE POUND GOLD COINS NOTICE 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice–

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the UEFA Euro 2020 – One Pound Gold Coins Notice 2020.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

3.(1) New coins of gold in the denomination of one pound shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part IX of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows–

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II QUEEN OF GIBRALTAR 2020” on the left side of the coin and the value and inscription “1/2g FINE GOLD .999 LEV” on the right side of the coin;

- (b) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts a trophy. The inscription reads “TROPHY” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (c) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts Skillzy, the official Mascot of the UEFA Euro 2020. The inscription reads “MASCOT” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (d) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the UEFA trophy, footballs and fans. The inscription reads “UEFA EURO 2020”;
- (e) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Baku Olympic Stadium and the Heydar Aliyev Prospect Overpass. The inscription reads “BAKU” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (f) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Stadio Olimpico and the Ponte Sant’Angelo. The inscription reads “ROME” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (g) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Gazprom Arena and the Exchange Bridge. The inscription reads “ST PETERSBURG” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (h) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts Hampden Park and the Clyde Arc. The inscription reads “GLASGOW” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (i) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Puskas Arena and the Szechenyi Chain Bridge. The inscription reads “BUDAPEST” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (j) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Parken Stadium and the Circle Bridge. The inscription reads “COPENHAGEN” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (k) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the San Mames Stadium and the San Anton Bridge. The inscription reads “BILBAO” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (l) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Johan Crujff Arena and the Magere Brug. The inscription reads “AMSTERDAM” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (m) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the Aviva Stadium and the Samuel Beckett Bridge. The inscription reads “DUBLIN” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;

- (n) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the National Arena Bucharest and the Basarab Overpass. The inscription reads “BUCHAREST” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (o) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the silhouette of a footballer kicking a ball and a silhouette of the UEFA trophy with the dates ‘1972’ ‘1980’ and ‘1996’ listed on the right side of the coin. The inscription reads “GERMANY” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (p) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the silhouette of a footballer kicking a ball and a silhouette of the UEFA trophy with the dates ‘1964’ ‘2008’ and ‘2012’ listed on the right side of the coin. The inscription reads “SPAIN” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (q) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression images that depict footballers celebrating, a sailing ship in the background and the UEFA trophy with the date ‘2016’ listed on the left side of the coin. An image that depicts the Portuguese Coat of Arms is on the right side of the coin. The inscription reads “PORTUGAL” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (r) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the silhouette of a goal keeper stopping a ball and the silhouette of the map of France with the date ‘1960’ on the left side of the coin. The inscription reads “FRANCE” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (s) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the silhouette of the map of Europe together with the circle of stars. The inscription reads “EUROPE” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base;
- (t) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts the offside rule. The inscription reads “OFFSIDE RULE” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base; and
- (u) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression an image that depicts two silhouettes of ancient footballers kicking a ball. The inscription reads “ANCIENT FOOTBALL” at the top edge of the coin and “UEFA EURO 2020” at the base.

Legal Tender.

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
