GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF OPERATION DYNAMO 80TH ANNIVERSARY COLLECTION – THE MIRACLE OF DUNKIRK COIN NOTICE 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

Title and commencement.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Operation Dynamo 80th Anniversary Collection – The Miracle of Dunkirk Coin Notice 2020 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of cupro nickel, silver and gold in the denominations of ¼ Crown, ½ Crown, Crown, Ten Pounds and Twenty Pounds shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Parts II, III and IX of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Parts of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II D G REGINA GIBRALTAR 2020” bordering the edge and value below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a flotilla of Little Ships on their voyage to Dunkirk with the aircraft in the skies above them. The inscription surrounding the design reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE 1940”;
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene of soldiers wading through the seas as in the background soldiers line up whilst looking up to the

skies. The inscription surrounding the design reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE 1940”;

- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an allied vessel after been hit from above by German aircraft, with troops from passing ships fearing for their fellow troops. The inscription surrounding the design reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE 1940”;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting the aftermath of a dogfight, showing an allied fighter plane looking back towards a damaged German plane in the background. The inscription surrounding the design reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE 1940”; and
- (f) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a train full of allied soldiers pulling into a train station waving and looking onwards in awe at the cheering crowds meeting them. The inscription surrounding the design reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE 1940”.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
