## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

### ISSUE OF OPERATION DYNAMO 80<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY COLLECTION – THE MIRACLE OF DUNKIRK – PART 2 COIN NOTICE 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Operation Dynamo 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Collection – The Miracle of Dunkirk – Part 2 Coin Notice 2020 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of gold and silver in the denominations of a quarter, half, one, double/two and five sovereigns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II D G REGINA GIBRALTAR 2020” bordering the edge and date of the year below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene of aircraft dropping bombs on a flotilla of little ships on their voyage to Dunkirk. The inscription on the bottom edge of the coin reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE 1940”;
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene of a stranded soldier on the beach, shielding himself from debris, after an attack by a German plane.

The inscription on the top edge of the coin reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE” and “1940” at the bottom edge.

- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene of soldiers wading through the seas towards the ships that were taking them home. The inscription on the top edge of the coin reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE 1940”;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting the scene of an allied fighting plane flying away from a destroyed German plane after a dogfight. The inscription surrounding the design reads “A MIRACLE OF DELIVERANCE 1940”; and
- (f) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene of a train full of allied soldiers pulling into a train station waving and looking onwards at the cheering crowds who met them. The inscription at the top edge of the coin reads “A MIRACLE OF” and the inscription at the bottom edge reads “DELIVERANCE 1940”.

**Legal Tender.**

- 4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
