## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

### ISSUE OF THE 50<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF DECIMALISATION 2021 COIN NOTICE 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Decimalisation 2021 Coin Notice 2021 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of cupro nickel, silver and gold in the denominations of ½ crown, crown and two/double crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH. II. D. G. REGINA GIBRALTAR 2021” bordering the edge and value below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the Wren motif that adorned the Farthing from 1936 to 1956. The Pounds, Shillings and Pence symbols are featured above the Wren motif together with the inscription ‘FARTHING’ below. The inscription around the design reads ‘BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS’ together with ‘1971-2021’ inscribed below;
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the sailing ship motif that adorned the Half Penny from 1953 to 1967. The inscription ‘HALF PENNY’ is

featured above the sailing ship motif together with the Pounds, Shillings and Pence symbols below. The inscription around the design reads 'BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS' together with '1971-2021' inscribed below;

- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the Portcullis motif that adorned the Threepence from 1953 to 1967. The inscription 'THREE' and 'PENNY' is featured on each side of the Portcullis motif together with the Pounds, Shillings and Pence symbols below. The inscription around the design reads 'BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS' together with '1971-2021' inscribed below;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the Britannia motif that adorned the Penny from 1953 to 1967. The inscriptions 'ONE' and 'PENNY' is featured on each side of the design together with the Pounds, Shillings and Pence symbols below. The inscription around the design reads 'BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS' together with '1971-2021' inscribed below;
- (f) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the Garland motif that adorned the Sixpence from 1953 to 1967. The inscriptions 'SIX PENCE', 'FID.' 'DEF' together with the Pounds, Shilling and Pence symbols are featured within the design. The inscription around the design reads 'BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS' together with '1971-2021' inscribed below;
- (g) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the English Shield motif that adorned the Shilling from 1953 to 1966. The inscriptions 'ONE SHILLING', 'FID.' 'DEF' together with the Pounds, Shilling and Pence symbols are featured within the design. The inscription around the design reads 'BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS' together with '1971-2021' inscribed below;
- (h) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the Scottish Shield motif that adorned the Shilling from 1953 to 1966. The inscriptions 'ONE SHILLING', 'FID.' 'DEF' together with the Pounds, Shilling and Pence symbols are featured within the design. The inscription around the design reads 'BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS' together with '1971-2021' inscribed below;
- (i) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the Tudor Rose motif that adorned the Florin from 1953 to 1967. The inscriptions 'TWO SHILLINGS', 'FID.' 'DEF' together with the Pounds, Shilling and Pence symbols are featured within the design. The inscription around the design reads 'BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS' together with '1971-2021' inscribed below;
- (j) the reverse impression shall bear a design featuring the Royal Arms motif that adorned the Half Crown from 1953 to 1967. The inscriptions 'HALF CROWN', 'FID.' 'DEF' together with the Pounds, Shilling and Pence symbols are featured within the design. The inscription around the design reads 'BRITAINS LAST PRE-DECIMAL COINS' together with '1971-2021' inscribed below.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
