GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE EMBLEMS OF A NATION COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of Emblems of A Nation Collection Coins Notice 2022 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

- 2.(1) New coins of cupro nickel, silver and gold in the denominations of one crown and two crowns/double crown shall be made.
- (2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

- 3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows
 - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II.D.G. REGINA. GIBRALTAR" bordering the edge, date of year and value below;
 - (b) the reverse impression shall bear an image of the national animal of England, the lion, holding the national flower, the Tudor Rose. The inscription surrounding the design reads 'EMBLEMS OF A NATION';
 - (c) the reverse impression shall bear an image of the national animal of Ireland, the hare, holding the national flower, the Shamrock. The inscription surrounding the design reads 'EMBLEMS OF A NATION';

- (d) the reverse impression shall bear an image of the national animal of Scotland, the Unicorn, holding the national flower, the Thistle. The inscription surrounding the design reads 'EMBLEMS OF A NATION';
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear an image of the national animal of Wales, the Dragon, holding the national flower, the Daffodil. The inscription surrounding the design reads 'EMBLEMS OF A NATION'.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
