GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE 80TH ANNIVERSARY OF BREAKING ENIGMA COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the 80th Anniversary of Breaking Enigma Collection Coins Notice 2022.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

3.(1) New coins of cupro nickel, silver and gold in the denominations fifty pence, one pound, five pounds and ten pounds shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part IX of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the Latin inscription ‘MONTIS INSIGNIA CALPE’. The inscription ‘GIBRALTAR’ is also included together with the year, denomination, weight and metal fineness of the coin. The design also includes elements of the machine that cracked the code;

- (b) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the Latin inscription 'MONTIS INSIGNIA CALPE'. The inscription 'GIBRALTAR' is also included together with the year, denomination, weight and metal fineness of the coin. The design also includes images of the four men who broke Enigma and an image of the four rotor Naval Enigma machine;
- (c) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression a merged design depicting an Enigma rotor, a rotor from the Bombe machine and images of the four men who broke Enigma. The inscription in the centre of the design reads 'THE CODE BREAKERS';
- (d) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression a merged design of an Enigma rotor with the circular spiked design and a rotor from the Bombe Machine. Letters circle around the outer border of the coin with a plate attached on top creating a moving element which will show the code 'E N I G M A' when moved to the correct position.

Legal Tender.

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
