LEGAL NOTICE NO. 127 OF 2022.

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE MOST FAMOUS BULLION COINS NOTICE 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Most Famous Bullion Coins Notice 2022.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

- 3.(1) New coins of silver in the denomination of ten pounds shall be made

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part IX of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coin shall bear on side 6 the Gibraltar Coat of Arms encircled with the inscriptions 'UNITED KINGDOM. AUSTRIA. MEXICO. UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. SOUTH AFRICA. CHINA. RUSSIA. AUSTRALIA. NEW ZEALAND. CANADA. 2022'. The inscription on the edge reads 'GIBRALTAR', 'MOST FAMOUS BULLION COINS' together with the weight, metal composition and value shown below.
- (b) the coin shall bear on side 5 a design depicting panda bears, a chinese landscape, St George and the Dragon and the Basilio's Cathedral. The inscription reads 'CHINA' and 'RUSSIA';

- (c) the coin shall bear on side 4 a design depicting Uluru, a kangaroo and a kiwi. The inscription reads 'AUSTRALIA' and 'NEW ZEALAND';
- (d) the coin shall bear on side 3 a design depicting an eagle, the Grand Canyon with the sun, a Springbok and landscape. The inscription reads 'UNITED STATES OF AMERICA' and 'SOUTH AFRICA';
- (e) the coin shall bear on side 2 a design depicting musical instruments, music notes and an image of The Angel of Independence. The inscription reads 'AUSTRIA' and 'MEXICO';
- (f) the coin shall bear on side 1 a design depicting a maple leaf and an image of Britannia. The inscription reads 'CANADA' and 'UNITED KINGDOM'.

Legal Tender.

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
