GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF HIBERNIA, THROUGH THE AGES COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice–

Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of Hibernia, Through the Ages Collection Coins Notice 2022 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold in the denominations of 1/5 Crown and 1 Crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows -

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression a design of the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the inscription 'GIBRALTAR' and 'MONTIS INSIGNIA CALPE' together with the date of year and value shown below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hibernia sitting in a meadow surrounded by a silhouette of a four-leaf clover. The inscription at the top edge reads 'ÉIRE THROUGH THE AGES';
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hibernia on horseback holding a spear. The inscription at the top edge reads 'IVERIU THROUGH THE AGES';

- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Hibernia seated, holding a cross. The inscription at the top edge reads 'ÉRIU THROUGH THE AGES';
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of the statue of Hibernia that stands atop of the GPO in Dublin. The inscription at the top edge reads 'HIBERNIA THROUGH THE AGES';
- (f) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a bust side portrait of Hibernia based on ancient and Celtic statues of old. The inscription at the top edge reads 'IOUERNÍĀ THROUGH THE AGES'.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
