### **GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990**

#### **ISSUE OF THE SWEDISH NAVY COINS NOTICE 2022**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

#### Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Swedish Navy Coins Notice 2022 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

#### Issue of new coins.

- 2.(1) New coins of gold in the denomination of one pound shall be made.
- (2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part IX of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### Design of the coins.

- 3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows
  - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the Gibraltar Coat of Arms encircled with the inscription "ELIZABETH II D G REGINA GIBRALTAR' together with the date of year and value. The inscription '2.5g FINE GOLD' is also included on the right;
  - (b) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression a design depicting the Swedish naval fleet in 1522. The inscription above the design reads 'FLOTTAN 500 ÅR' together with the inscription '7 JUNI 1522-2022' below the design;
  - (c) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression a design depicting the modern ships seen in 2022 used by the Swedish Navy. The inscription above the design reads 'FLOTTAN 500 ÅR' together with the inscription '7 JUNI 1522-2022' below the design.

## Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
