GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

ISSUE OF THE MICHAEL COLLINS SPIRIT OF A SOLDIER COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Michael Collins Spirit of a Soldier Collection Coins Notice 2022 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of cupro nickel and gold in the denominations of 1/10, 1/2, 1 and Two Crowns/Double Crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3.(1) The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression a design of the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the inscription ‘GIBRALTAR’ and ‘MONTIS INSIGNIA CALPE’ together with the date of year and value shown below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Michael Collins. The inscription surrounding the edge reads ‘GENERAL MÍCHEÁL Ó COILEÁIN COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF OF THE IRISH ARMY’. The inscription below reads ‘16 OCTOBER 1890 – 22 AUGUST 1922’;

- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Michael Collins. The inscription surrounding the edge reads ‘MÍCHEÁL Ó COILEÁIN AIDE-DE-CAMP TO JOSEPH PLUNKETT’. The inscription below reads ‘16 OCTOBER 1890 – 22 AUGUST 1922’;
- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Michael Collins. The inscription surrounding the edge reads ‘MÍCHEÁL Ó COILEÁIN DIRECTOR OF ORGANISATION IN THE VOLUNTEERS’. The inscription below reads ‘16 OCTOBER 1890 – 22 AUGUST 1922’;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of Michael Collins. The inscription surrounding the edge reads ‘MÍCHEÁL Ó COILEÁIN CHAIRMAN OF THE PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT’. The inscription below reads ‘16 OCTOBER 1890 – 22 AUGUST 1922’;
- (f) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an image of a Calla Lily surrounded by intricate Celtic knotwork. The inscription surrounding the edge reads ‘100 YEARS OF FREEDOM HIS SACRIFICE FOR OUR FREEDOM’.

Legal Tender.

- 4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
