LEGAL NOTICE NO. 130 OF 2023

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE ELVIS PRESLEY COLLECTION PART THREE COINS NOTICE 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Elvis Presley Collection Part Three, Coins Notice 2023 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold and silver in the denominations of one crown, two/double crowns, 1/25 crowns, 1/10 crowns, 1/5 crowns and half-crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the obverse depicts the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with Latin inscription; • CHARLES III • D • G • REX • F • D • GIBRALTAR, which translates to CHARLES III • BY THE GRACE OF GOD • DEFENDER OF THE FAITH • KING OF GIBRALTAR and includes the denomination and the year in which the coin is struck;
- (b) the reverse design is inspired by an original photograph of the King of Rock ‘n’ Roll, Elvis Presley, as he performs on the Milton Berle Show on June 5th, 1956;

- (c) the reverse design is inspired by an original photograph of the King of Rock ‘n’ Roll, Elvis Presley, as he performs in Rapid City, South Dakota on June 21st, 1977;
- (d) the reverse design is inspired by an original photograph of the King of Rock ‘n’ Roll, Elvis Presley, as he performs in Aloha from Hawaii on January 14th, 1973;
- (e) the reverse design is inspired by an original photograph of the King of Rock ‘n’ Roll, Elvis Presley, as he performs on January 28th, 1956 on the Dorsey Brothers’ Stage Show.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
