GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE 2023 GOD SAVE THE KING COLLECTION, COINS NOTICE 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

Title and commencement.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the 2023 God Save the King Collection, Coins Notice 2023 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of cupro nickel, silver and gold in the denominations of a Quarter, Half, One, Double/Two, Five/Quintuple Sovereigns, One Crown, Two/Double Crowns, Half Crowns, 1/25th Crowns, Ten Pounds, Twenty-five Pounds and One Hundred Pounds shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Parts II, VII and IX of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows -

- (a) The design depicts the newly sculpted Raphael Maklouf effigy of King Charles III and the Latin inscription reading; CHARLES III D G REX F D GIBRALTAR •, which reads as; CHARLES III BY THE GRACE OF GOD DEFENDER OF THE FAITH KING OF GIBRALTAR and includes the denomination and the year in which the coin is struck.
- (b) The design depicts the newly sculpted Raphael Maklouf effigy of King Charles III and the year in which the coin is struck, with the Latin inscription reading; CHARLES III DEI GRA REX F D GIBRALTAR •, which reads as; CHARLES III BY THE GRACE OF GOD DEFENDER OF THE FAITH •

KING OF GIBRALTAR • the Sovereign Obverse does not include a denominational value as it is determined by its size, weight, and diameter.

(c) The reverse designs depict the cypher of King Charles III, alongside the inscription, 'HIS • MAJESTY • KING • CHARLES • III', sprigs of oak inspired by the House of Windsor Crest as a symbol of strength and longevity, the crowned shield taken from The King's official Coat of Arms, and the inscription, '• LONG • TO • REIGN • OVER • US • GOD • SAVE • THE • KING'.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
