## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

### ISSUE OF THE REVOLUTIONARY LEGACY COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of Revolutionary Legacy Collection Coins Notice 2023 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of Gold and Silver in the denominations of 1/10, 1/5, One Crown and Two/Double Crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the inscription “GIBRALTAR - MONTIS INSIGNIA CALPE” and includes the denomination and the year in which the coin is struck;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting different elements that together show a timeline of Ireland gaining independence. To the left of the design are Calla lilies, with a depiction of soldiers who fought during the Irish Rebellion of 1798. The right half of the design depicts the tri - colour Irish flag following the Irish War of Independence and a portrait of Hibernia. The inscription reads “THE IRISH REBELLION OF 1798”;

- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting different elements that show America gaining independence. Soldiers who fought in the American Revolution can be seen in their military uniforms holding Brown Bess muskets, with the American flag flowing above and Lady Liberty to the right of the design indicating their independence. The inscription reads “AMERICAN REVOLUTION, 1775 – 1784”;
- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design that features Marianne to the left, the embodiment of France. The right side of the design shows those who fought in the French Revolution with the French flag flowing above and the words “Liberte, Egalite, Fraternite” are on the ribbon across the design. The inscription reads “THE FRENCH REVOLUTION, 1789- 1799” and “LIBERTE, EGALITE AND FRATERNITE”.

**Legal Tender.**

- 4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
