GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

ISSUE OF THE GIBRALTAR PLANE CRASH COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Gibraltar Plane Crash Collection Coins Notice 2023 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold and silver in the denominations of 1/10, ½ and one Crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the obverse depicts the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the inscription “GIBRALTAR - MONTIS INSIGNIA CALPE” and includes the denomination and the year in which the coin is struck;
- (b) the reverse design has the inscriptions “THE GIBRALTAR PLANE CRASH 4.07.1943” and “LT- Gen Wladyslaw Sikorski”;
- (c) the reverse design depicts “Lieutenant General Wladyslaw Sikorski’ and a “4.07.1943” shaped to form the Rock of Gibraltar with another inscription reading “80th ANNIVERSARY OF THE PLANE CRASH IN GIBRALTAR”;

- (d) the reverse design has the inscription “80th ANNIVERSARY OF THE GIBRALTAR PLANE CRASH 4.07.1943” and “Lieutenant General WLADYSLAW SIKORSKI”;

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
