## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

### ISSUE OF THE REMEMBRANCE 2023 COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Remembrance 2023 Collection Coins Notice 2023 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of Gold, Cupro Nickel and Humanium in the denominations of 1/10, ½, 1/5 and One Crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the inscription “GIBRALTAR - MONTIS INSIGNIA CALPE” and includes the denomination and the year in which the coin is struck;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a soldier in uniform, based on original photograph taken of the Irish War of Independence, standing in front of the GPO, the headquarters during the Easter Rising. Calla Lilies surrounds this design with the inscription “PEOPLE WILL SAY HARD THINGS OF US NOW BUT WE SHALL BE REMEMBERED BY POSTERITY AND BLESSED BY UNBORN GENERATIONS”;

- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a portrait of Hibernia, the personification of Ireland, holding a Calla Lily. The inscription surrounding Hibernia reads “OUR DEEDS OF LAST WEEK ARE THE MOST SPLENDID IN IRELAND’S HISTORY”;
- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting the full body image of an Irish soldier during the Irish War of Independence. Calla Lilies can be seen to the right of the soldier surrounded by the inscription “WE HAVE PRESERVED IRELAND’S HONOUR AND OUR OWN”;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting an Irish military hat encompassed by Calla lilies. The design has two inscriptions, the first reading “YOU MUST NOT GRIEVE FOR ALL OF THIS” and the second “COGADH NA SAOIRSE” that translates to “IRISH WAR OF INDEPENDENCE”.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
