GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

ISSUE OF OPERATION GUNNERSIDE PART TWO ‘HEAVY WATER’ COINS NOTICE 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of Operation Gunnerside Part Two ‘Heavy Water’, Coins Notice 2023 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold and tombac in the denominations of One Crown and Two /Double Crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the Gibraltar Coat of Arms encircled with the inscription “CHARLES III. D. G REX. F. D. GIBRALTAR’ together with value and date of year below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene of soldiers and parachutes in Operation Grouse. The inscription at the top edge reads “OPERATION GROUSE”;
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene of soldiers and fighter planes in Operation Freshman. The inscription at the top edge reads “OPERATION FRESHMAN”;

- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene of a battle ship in the Tinnsjo Operation. The inscription at the top edge reads “TINNSJO OPERATION”;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a portrait of Leif Tronstad. The inscription at the top edge reads “HEROES OF TELEMAR” together with the dates “1903” and “1945”. The inscription below reads “LEIF TRONSTAD”;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear an image of a radioactive sign. The inscription at the top edge reads “HEROES OF TELEMAR” together with the dates “1942” and “1944” shown below.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
