## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

### ISSUE OF THE PENNY BLACK COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Penny Black Collection Coins Notice 2023 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of Cupro Nickel, Silver and Gold in the denominations of 1/10 Crown, 1/25 Crown, ½ Crown, 1 Crown, 1/5 Crown and Fifty Pence shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Parts I and II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the crown coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of His Majesty King Charles III with the inscription “CHARLES III D.G. REX F.D. GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, date of the year and value below;
- (b) the fifty pence coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of His Majesty King Charles III with the inscription “CHARLES III. KING OF GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, date of the year and value below;
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear the design of the original Penny Black Stamp – the world’s first postage stamp issued during the reign of Queen Victoria. The inscription reads, “POSTAGE ONE PENNY”;

- (d) the reverse impression shall bear the design of the original Penny Black Stamp – the world’s first postage stamp issued during the reign of Queen Victoria. The inscription reads, “POSTAGE TWO PENCE”.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
