## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

### ISSUE OF THE HOWARD CARTER 150<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY COLLECTION COINS NOTICE 2024

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Howard Carter 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Collection Coins Notice 2024 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of gold in the denominations of 1/25<sup>th</sup> Crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the obverse depicts the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with Latin inscription “CHARLES III • D • G • REX • F • D • GIBRALTAR” which translates to “CHARLES III • BY THE GRACE OF GOD • DEFENDER OF THE FAITH • KING OF GIBRALTAR” and includes the denomination and the year in which the coin is struck;
- (b) the reverse design depicts Howard Carter with hat and bow tie. In the background, there are Ancient Egypt hieroglyphs. The inscription reads “HOWARD CARTER 1874-1939”.

#### **Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
