## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

### ISSUE OF THE GIBRALTAR CIRCULATING CURRENCY COLLECTION 2024 COINS NOTICE 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Gibraltar Circulating Currency Collection 2024 Coins Notice 2025 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of Copper Plated Steel, Nickel Plated Steel, Cupro Nickel, Nickel Brass, Mixed Metal and Alpaca in the denominations of one, two, five, ten, twenty, fifty pence, one pound, two pounds and five pounds shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) The obverse designs depict the Raphael Maklouf effigy of King Charles III and the inscription reading “CHARLES III KING OF GIBRALTAR” and includes the value and year in which the coin is struck;
- (b) The reverse one pence design depicts King Charles III Cypher with wreath;
- (c) The reverse two pence design depicts the Windsor Castle;
- (d) The reverse five pence design depicts the Orb a representation of the sovereign's power;
- (e) The reverse ten pence design depicts the King's sceptre with a cross, which represents the sovereign's temporal power;

- (f) The reverse Twenty pence design depicts the Crown and inscription reading, “LONG TO REIGN OVER US • GOD SAVE THE KING”;
- (g) The reverse fifty pence design depicts Westminster Abbey door, and inscription reading, “THE CORONATION OF HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES III • 06.05.2023”;
- (h) The reverse one-pound design depicts the Coronation Chair and inscription reading, “LONG TO REIGN OVER US • GOD SAVE THE KING”;
- (i) The reverse two-pound design depicts the Gibraltar Crest and inscription reading, “HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES III • GOD SAVE THE KING”;
- (j) The reverse five-pound design depicts the Gibraltar Coat of arms.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
