GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE BATTLE OF BRITAIN COLLECTION – PART 2 COINS NOTICE 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice–

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Battle of Britain Collection – Part 2 Coins Notice 2025.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

3.(1) New coins of cupro-nickel and gold in the denomination of Half Crowns, One Crown and Two Crowns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the inscription “CHARLES III D G REX F D GIBRALTAR 2025” bordering the edge and value below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design that depicts a design of pilots scrambling to their aircraft. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN 85 1940 2025”;

- (c) the reverse impression shall depict a design of the Armstrong Whitworth Whitley in flight over German invasion barges. A military personnel is depicted on the left and constellations in the background. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN 85 THE NIGHT STALKER”;
- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design that depicts the Vickers Wellington in flight above searchlights and a member of the Observer Corps on the left. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN 85 THE DURABILITY”;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design that depicts the Bristol Blenheim over radar towers and a pilot on the left. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN 85 THE TRAILBLAZER”;
- (f) the reverse impression shall bear a design that depicts pilots together with two Hawker Hurricanes, with a wasp on the front of one. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN 85 THE WORKHORSE”;
- (g) the reverse impression shall bear a design that depicts the Supermarine Spitfire with two pilots, one sitting inside the cockpit. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN 85 THE ICON”;
- (h) the reverse impression shall bear an image RAF members smiling after victory in the Battle of Britain. Also depicted in the background is a Battle of Britain clasp and a fighter aircraft. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN 85 SO MUCH SO MANY SO FEW”.

Legal tender.

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
