GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE BATTLE OF BRITAIN PART 3 COLLECTION COIN NOTICE 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Battle of Britain Part 3 Collection Coin Notice 2025 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of Gold in the denominations of 1/8 Sovereign, Quarter Sovereign, Half Sovereign, One Sovereign, Double Sovereign and Quintuple Sovereign shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Parts VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of His Majesty King Charles III with the inscription; “• CHARLES III • DEI • GRA • REX • F • D • GIBRALTAR •” and the date of year along the bottom edge;
- (b) the reverse impression shall depict a pilot in the cockpit of a plane. The inscription reads “85TH ANNIVERSARY • BATTLE OF BRITAIN • 1940-2025” along the edge;
- (c) the reverse impression shall depict Air Chief Marshall Hugh Dowding in front a Navy Ship and Aircraft off the White Cliffs of Dover. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN • DEFENDING THE CHANNEL” along the left edge;

- (d) the reverse impression shall depict Robert Watson-Watt in front of an air base under attack. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN • STRIKE ON THE AIRFORCE” along the left edge;
- (e) the reverse impression shall depict a member of the Observer Corps and Douglas Bader in front of St. Paul’s Cathedral with enemy aircraft flying above. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN • BRITAIN STANDS STRONG” along the left edge;
- (f) the reverse impression shall depict the beginning of the Blitz, with Josef Frantisek at the forefront. The inscription reads “BATTLE OF BRITAIN • TURNING THE TIDE” along the left edge;
- (g) the reverse impression shall depict a Spitfire creating a V shape in the sky behind Winston Churchill. The inscription alongside Winston Churchill reads “SO MUCH, SO MANY, SO FEW” and “BATTLE OF BRITAIN • VICTORY IN THE SKIES” along the left edge.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
