GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE ANNUAL SOVEREIGN COLLECTION COIN NOTICE 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Annual Sovereign Collection Coin Notice 2025.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

- 3.(1) New coins of gold and silver in the denomination of Eight Sovereign, Quarter Sovereign, Half Sovereign, One Sovereign, Double Sovereign and Quintuple Sovereign shall be made.
- (2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

- 4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows
 - (a) the sovereign design depicts the effigy of King Charles III and the year in which the coin is struck, with the inscription reading "• CHARLES III DEI GRA REX F D GIBRALTAR•";
 - (b) the reverse design shall bare the Royal Coat of Arms over a Tudor Rose;
 - (c) the reverse design shall bare the Royal Coat of Arms over a Tudor Rose with the inscription "IHESUS AUTEM TRANSIENS PER MEDIUM ILLORUM IBAT" along the edge;

- (d) the reverse design shall bare the Royal Coat of Arms and Saint Edward Crown over a Tudor Rose with the inscription "IHESUS AUTEM TRANSIENS PER MEDIUM ILLORUM IBAT" along the edge; and
- (e) the reverse design shall bare the Royal Coat of Arms and Saint Edward Crown over a Tudor Rose with the inscription "IHESUS AUTEM TRANSIENS PER MEDIUM ILLORUM IBAT" along the inner edge and "• HONI SOIT QUI M AL Y PENSE •".

Legal tender.

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
