## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

### ISSUE OF THE SS CITY OF CAIRO - REMEMBERED COLLECTION PART TWO COIN NOTICE 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

#### **Title.**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the SS City of Cairo – Remembered Collection Part Two Coin Notice 2026.

#### **Commencement.**

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

- 3.(1) New coins of cupro-nickel in the denominations of half-crown and one crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule

#### **Design of the coins.**

4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –
  - (a) the obverse design depicts the effigy of King Charles III, the year in which the coin is struck and the denomination, with the inscription reading; “• CHARLES III • D • G • REX • F • D • GIBRALTAR•”;
  - (b) the reverse design shall bare an impression of a female and her young children waiting to board SS City of Cairo, depicted in the background. The inscription “CITY OF CAIRO” is also written inside a compass on the left side of the design

together with the inscription “GOODNIGHT • SORRY FOR SINKING YOU” along the top edge;

- (c) the reverse design shall bare an impression of Karl-Friedrich Marten alongside the U-boat U-68. The inscription “CITY OF CAIRO” is also written inside a compass on the left side of the design together with the inscription “GOODNIGHT • SORRY FOR SINKING YOU” along the top edge;
- (d) the reverse design shall bare an impression of two lifeboats at sea. The inscription “CITY OF CAIRO” is also written inside a compass on the left side of the design together with the inscription “GOODNIGHT • SORRY FOR SINKING YOU” along the top edge; and
- (e) the reverse design shall bare an impression of the obverses and reverse of three coins found aboard the SS City of Cairo together with the plaque placed at the bottom of the ocean. The inscription “CITY OF CAIRO” is also written inside a compass in the centre of the design together with the inscription “GOODNIGHT • SORRY FOR SINKING YOU • NOVEMBER 2011” along the top edge.

**Legal tender.**

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
