LEGAL NOTICE NO. 103 OF 2026

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE PRINCE AND PRINCESS OF WALES' WEDDING ANNIVERSARY COLLECTION, COINS NOTICE 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Prince and Princess of Wales' Wedding Anniversary Collection, Coins Notice 2026 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of Gold and Silver, in the denominations of a quarter, one and five sovereigns, shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows –

- (a) The obverse design depicts the effigy of King Charles III. The inscription around the edge shall read; • CHARLES III • DEI • GRA • REX • F • D • GIBRALTAR • together with the year shown below;
- (b) The reverse design depicts a conjoined portrait of William and Catherine facing right with a rose at the bottom centre position. In the centre of the rose a crystal stone is embedded to mark the crystal anniversary;

- (c) The reverse design depicts a conjoined portrait of William and Catherine facing right together with a rose and a wreath positioned at the bottom centre. The wreath is made up of flowers from Catherine's wedding bouquet. The inscription around the edge reads 'HONI •.SOIT • QUI • MAL • PENSE';
- (d) The reverse design depicts a conjoined portrait of William and Catherine facing right, encircled by a wreath composed of flowers from Catherine's wedding bouquet, with a rose positioned at the bottom centre. The inscription around the edge reads 'HONI •.SOIT • QUI • MAL • PENSE'.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
