## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

### ISSUE OF THE ROYAL HOUSE OF NORWAY IN PICTURES – KING HAAKON VII, COINS NOTICE 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice–

#### **Title and commencement.**

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Royal House of Norway in Pictures – King Haakon VII, Coins Notice 2026 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of Cupro Nickel and Gold, in the denominations of 1/25, 1/10 and one crown, shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows–

- (a) the obverse design depicts the new Gibraltar Coat of Arms with the inscription; “• CHARLES III • D • G • REX • F • D • GIBRALTAR •” followed by the year in which the coin is struck and “•” thereafter, and the denomination below;
- (b) the reverse design depicts a photographic image of the Royal Family’s return from exile in 1945 with the inscription at the top edge “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below;
- (c) the reverse design depicts a photographic image of King Haakon VII and Queen Maud on his coronation with the inscription at the top edge “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below;

- (d) the reverse design depicts a photographic image of the official portrait of King Haakon VII with the inscription at the top edge “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below;
- (e) the reverse design depicts a photographic image of King Haakon VII and Crown Prince Olav in uniform with the inscription at the top edge “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below;
- (f) the reverse design depicts a photographic image commemorating the Referendum in 1905 with the inscription at the top edge “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below;
- (g) the reverse design depicts a photographic image of King Haakon VII, Crown Prince Olav and Prince Harald on a skiing trip with the inscription at the top edge “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below;
- (h) the reverse design depicts a photographic image of King Haakon VII waving to the children’s procession from the Palace Balcony with the inscription at the top edge “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below;
- (i) the reverse design depicts a photographic image of King Haakon VII together with Crown Prince Olav and Prince Harald with the inscription at the top edge “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below;
- (j) the reverse design depicts a photographic image of King Haakon VII in exile in London 1940, wearing military uniform with an inscription at the top edge reads “ALT FOR NORGE” and an image of the Royal Palace, Oslo, Norway below; and
- (k) the reverse design depicts a side portrait of King Haakon VII with the inscription on the right edge of the coin “KONG HAAKON VII • ALT FOR NORGE”.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
