LEGAL NOTICE NO. 215 OF 2025

IMPORTS AND EXPORTS ACT, 1986

IMPORTS AND EXPORTS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 16, 66 and 129 of the Imports and Exports Act, 1986, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Imports and Exports (Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2025.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 30 June 2025.

Amendment of Schedule 1.

3. In paragraph 24(3) of Schedule 1 to the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987—

- (a) at the end of subsubparagraph (c) omit “or”;
- (b) at the end of subsubparagraph (d) for “.” substitute “;”;
- (c) after subsubparagraph (d) insert-

“(e) motor vehicles that have-

- (i) a certificate of conformity; or
- (ii) a vehicle registration certificate,

issued in a Member State of the European Union, and in this subsubparagraph-

“certificate of conformity” means a certificate that has been issued in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/858 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2018 on the approval and market surveillance of motor vehicles and their trailers, and of systems, components and separate technical units intended for such vehicles, amending Regulations (EC) No

715/2007 and (EC) No 595/2009 and repealing Directive 2007/46/EC, as amended from time to time, and as it has effect in EU law;

“vehicle registration certificate” means a document that certifies that a vehicle is registered in a member State of the European Union, and which conforms with Council Directive 1999/37/EC of 29 April 1999 on the registration documents for vehicles, as amended from time to time, and as it has effect in EU law; or

- (f) motor vehicles that have-
 - (i) a certificate of conformity; or
 - (ii) a vehicle registration document,

issued in the United Kingdom, and

“certificate of conformity” means a certificate that has been issued in the United Kingdom in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/858 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2018 on the approval and market surveillance of motor vehicles and their trailers, and of systems, components and separate technical units intended for such vehicles, amending Regulations (EC) No 715/2007 and (EC) No 595/2009 and repealing Directive 2007/46/EC, as amended from time to time, and as it has effect in UK law;

“vehicle registration document” means a document that certifies that a vehicle is registered in the United Kingdom.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations amend the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations, 1987 in order to permit the importation of vehicles, from the EU and the UK, that are older than 5 years, upon production of relevant documentation.
