Classes of order:

- 1.** An order in proceedings with respect to the maintenance of a party to a marriage or of a child of a marriage.
- 2.** Subject to the provisions of paragraph 3 an order for the payment of—
 - (a) weekly or other periodical sums for the maintenance and education of an ex-nuptial child who has not attained the age of 18 years;
 - (b) the expenses incidental to the birth of an ex-nuptial child; and
 - (c) if an ex-nuptial child has died before the making of the order, the child's funeral expenses.
- 3.** An order of a kind specified in paragraph 2 shall not be capable of enforcement unless it appears to the magistrates' court from the certified copy of the order or any other documents transmitted to it that the person against whom the order was made—
 - (a) was served with a summons to appear in the proceedings in which the order was made; and
