MEDICAL AND HEALTH ACT.

HOSPITAL (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1989.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 40 of the Medical and Health Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules:

Title and Commencement.

- 1.(1) These rules may be cited as the Hospital (Amendment) Rules, 1989.
- (2) These rules shall come into operation on the 1st day of October 1989.

Amendment of Rule 4.

2. The Hospital Rules (hereinafter called the principal rules) are amended by revoking rule 4 and substituting therefor the following rules:

"Fees payable by in-patients.	4.(1) In respect of an entitled person admitted to a public ward, there shall be payable the fees set out in the first column of Schedule 1.		
	(2) In respect of an entitled person admitted to a private ward, there shall be payable the fees set out in the second column of Schedule 1.		
	Provided that an entitled person coming within subparagraphs (c) and (d) of the definition of "entitled person" contained in Rule 2 shall pay fees as a non-entitled person when in a private ward.		
	(3) In respect of a non-entitled person admitted to a private ward, there shall be payable the fees set out in the third column of Schedule 1.		

(4) Any patient admitted in the first instance to a public ward, who, within three weeks of such admission, is at his own request transferred to a private ward shall pay the fees set out in the second or third column of Schedule 1 for services (other than accommodation) payable in respect of a private ward as from the date of admission to the public ward.
(5) Where any operation is performed on any patient, the General Manager may in his discretion upon being satisfied that in the circumstances of the case it is equitable so to do, direct that the fee to be charged in respect of that operation shall be such as he certifies to be the correct sum payable.".

3. The principal rules are further amended by revoking Rule 5 and substituting therefor the following rule:

"Fees payable by out-patients.	5. For every attendance or treatment of an entitled or non-entitled person as an outpatient at any dispensary or clinic conducted at or in connection with a hospital there shall be payable the fees set out in Schedule 1, as the case may be:	
	Provided that:	
	(a) the General Manager may, because of the financial circumstances of the outpatient or of any person liable for the payment of the fees, remit the fees in whole or in part;	
	(b) no fee shall be payable by any entitled person, who is not a	

private patient, in respect of			
any attendance at an ante-natal			
clinic.".			
4. Rule 6 of the principal rules is amended by omitting the expression "First and Second Schedules" and substituting therefor the expression "Schedule 1".			
5. The principal rules are further amended by repealing rule 7.			
6. The principal rules are further amended by revoking Schedule 1 and substituting therefor the following Schedule:

- 1. Members of the Group Practice Medical Scheme shall only be entitled to receive free treatment if they have been referred for consultation by a doctor under the scheme.
- 2. The General Manager may, because of the financial circumstances of the patient or, of any person liable for the payment of the fees, remit the fee in whole or in part.
- 3. There shall be no entitlement to free medicines for out patients who access services privately.

- 4. The results of private diagnostic investigations form part of the private medical record owned by the requesting practitioner.
- 5. The cost of appliances provided for private patients will be met by the patient concerned. In other cases the patient's share of the cost of the appliances will be determined by a means test.".
- 6. The principal rules are further amended by repealing Schedules 1 and 4. Dated this 28th day of September, 1989.
