**MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT.
(Cap. 106).**

PILOTS (AMENDMENT) RULES 1985.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 181 of the Merchant Shipping Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules:

Title

1. (1) These rules may be cited as the Pilots (Amendment) rules, 1985.

Amendment of Part 1 of Second Schedule of booklet 3 of cap. 106.

2. Part I of the Second Schedule to the Pilots Rules is amended by revoking paragraph 3 and substituting the following paragraph:

"3. Pilotage of dead ships, oil rigs, vessels not under command and vessels docking into and undocking out of drydocks:

As in paragraph 1 plus 100 % ".
