MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT

PILOTS (AMENDMENT) RULES 2002

The Governor, in exercise of his powers under section 181 of the Merchant Shipping Act, and all other enabling powers, makes the following rules—

Title and commencement.

1. These rules may be cited as the Pilots (Amendment) Rules 2002 and come into operation on 1 November 2002.

Revocation of rule 20 and Schedules 4 and 5.

2. Rule 20 of and schedules 4 and 5 to the Pilots Rules are revoked.

Replacement of Schedule 4.

3. The following is inserted as Schedule 4 to the Pilots Rules—

Pilotage Fees

Supplement	
(E) Dead Ship Supplement (inc. Oil rigs and vessels not under command)	Flat rate fee across the board of £60
(F) Running Lines (per boat crew)	Flat rate fee across the board of £30 (only applicable to Rate B) Vessels less than 500grt are exempt
(G) Attendance charge	A Charge of £50 can be made where there is a cost implication to the pilotage operation and must be justified.
(H) Pilotage Exemption Charge	Calculated on the minimum chargeable amount within the appropriate tonnage band
(I) Attendance Service Not required	Flat rate fee across the board of £50 (only applies when pilot attends vessel but is not required due to circumstances beyond his control).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These rules remove the Pilotage Administration Charge from the Pilots Rules following the abolition of the Pilotage Fund, and replace the fees payable to the Pilots.
