MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT

GIBRALTAR MERCHANT SHIPPING (PORT STATE CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 223A of the Merchant Shipping Act, and all other enabling powers, the Minister, for the purposes of transposing into the law of Article 4 of Directive 2002/84/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 November 2002 amending the Directives on maritime safety and prevention of pollution from ships which amends Directive 95/21/EC, has made the following Regulations:

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Port State Control) (Amendment) Regulations 2004.

Amendment to regulation 2.

2. Regulation 2 of the Gibraltar Merchant Shipping (Port State Control) Regulations, 2003 is amended—

- (a) in the definition of “conventions” by substituting “ in its up-to-date version as in force in the Member State at the time of reference” for the words “, which at the time of reference, may be in force in the Member State”;
- (b) in the definition of “Directive” by substituting “, Directive 2001/106/EC and Directive 2002/84/EC” for the words “and Directive 2001/106/EC”; and
- (c) in the definition of “MOU” by substituting “ in its up-to date version as in force at the time of reference” for the words “ as it stands on the date of reference”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations transpose into the law of Gibraltar Article 4 of Directive 2002/84/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 November 2002 amending the Directives on maritime safety and prevention of pollution from ships.
