PENSIONS ACT

PENSIONS (AMENDMENT No.1) REGULATIONS 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 3 of the Pensions Act and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Regulations-

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment No.1) Regulations 2026.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to Regulation 4 of the Pensions Regulations.

3. Regulation 4 of the Pensions Regulations is amended by-

- (a) inserting the following after regulation 4(1A)-

“(1B) Where an officer to whom this regulation applies-

- (a) was a police officer or a customs officer, and he was transferred from the police force or customs under exceptional circumstances as approved by the Government, to a Government Department, Statutory Authority, Agency or any wholly owned Government company or corporation provided that the names of any such Statutory Authorities or Agencies have been so prescribed by the Government by Notice in the Gazette under section 6(1)(d); and the names of any such wholly owned Government companies or corporations have been so prescribed by the Government by notice in the Gazette under section 6(1)(e); and
- (b) at the time of the transfer such person is entitled to a pension, gratuity or allowance under these regulations,

subregulation (1) shall apply to that officer (as the case may be) but as if he was still in the police force or in customs, as a police officer or customs officer.”; and

(b) revoking regulation 4(2).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations amend the Pension Regulations for the purposes of establishing the pensionable status of transferring pensionable police and customs officers.
